**Equipment requirements:** Scouts will need: sleeping bag, tent, hiking shoes, clothes to suit weather, flashlight & scout handbook, etc.. Check the scout handbook camping checklist for additional recommended camping gear or equipment. Confirm any specific gear needs with your patrol leader.

**Medications:** Make sure any required medicines are turned in using zip-lock bag (marked with Scouts name) in the original container and a Medication Release form is completed. Scouts that need frequent Over-the-counter (OTC) meds should have an OTC medication form on file.
